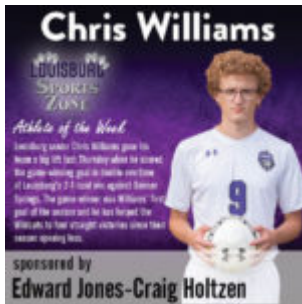


Week 2 Athlete of the Week: Chris Williams

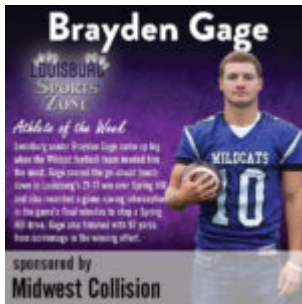

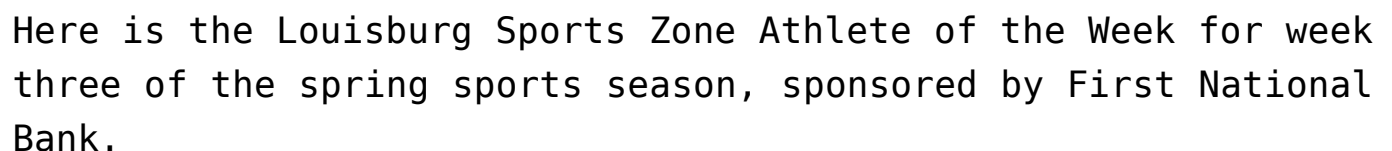
